



KINDERGARTEN MEMORY VERSES

*"I have hidden your word in my heart that I

Each week there will be a scripture memory verse to reinforce the Bible lesson taught that week. Verses will be introduced on Monday and evaluated on Friday. The student memorizing the most verses (the class verses and extra credit verses) will receive a plaque at the end of the year award ceremony in May.

A list of the year's verses can be found on the back of this page. A good place to keep this list of verses might be on your child's night stand where scripture review can become a part of the nightly bedtime routine. The refrigerator could also be an ideal place to have it handy for review at mealtimes or in the car. Consistent review of verses at home is essential for retention.

Scripture Memory Verses will be tracked with the classroom memory verse trains. Each child's name will be put on an train engine. They will receive a car for their train for each verse memorized.
